August Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights

Although the United States doesn't celebrate any official holidays during the month of August, we do celebrate many great inventions, works of art, and scientific discoveries.

August 1

- 1900 "The Wonderful Wizard of Oz" by L. Frank Baum was copyright registered.
- 1941 The first Jeep rolled off the assembly line; Willy's Truck Company was the first company to create a jeep.

August 2

• 1904 A patent for a "glass shaping machine" was granted to Michael Owen. The immense production of glass bottles and jars today owes its inception to this invention.

August 4

• 1970 "Poppin Fresh" was a trademark registered by the Pillsbury Company.

August 6

• 1935 William Coolidge obtained a patent for the cathode ray tube, a critical ingredient of TV and other electronic applications.

August 9

• 1898 Rudolf Diesel was granted a patent for an "internal combustion engine" known as the diesel engine.

• 1909 The Ford trademark was registered by the Ford Motor Corporation.

August 12

• 1930 Clarence Birdseye patented a method for packaging frozen foods.

August 13

• 1890 A publisher copyright registered an edition of Nathaniel Hawthorne's "The Scarlet Letter."

August 19

• 1888 The first world beauty contest was held in Belgium, an 18year old West Indian woman won.

August 27

• 1855 Clara Barton became the first female federal employee to achieve equal status when she was hired by the Patent Office as a clerk.

August 29

• 1893 Whitcomb Judson received a patent for the zipper.



I think I've done a review of this author previously. She's prolific and I enjoy her "easy reading" mysteries. If you're looking for intellectual stimulation, you would probably not be reading fiction and certainly not Clark. I once taught high school English, so, I guess I've read a little of everything. I read cereal boxes as a child because my mother wouldn't let us bring books to the table. I confess to doing that as an adult when I'm dining alone.

Moonlight Becomes You

Maggie Holloway is a young fashion photographer who lives in New York. The story begins with a description of Maggie having been buried alive in a coffin. Chapter 1 takes us back two weeks to Maggie being bored at a cocktail party because her date has abandoned her while he seeks out guests with whom he can promote his own business interests. Maggie leaves without telling her date, Liam, who is her on and off love interest.

Maggie's former stepmother, Nuala Moore has invited her to visit her in Newport, RI where Nuala lives. Maggie decides to take her up on it.

When Maggie arrives, she finds that Nuala has been murdered in what appears to be a break-in robbery attempt. Surprisingly, Nuala has left her huge Victorian home to Maggie with a request that Maggie occasionally check up on Nuala's old friend Greta Shipley. Greta has recently moved to a retirement home which is important to the plot. Maggie takes Greta to visit the cemetery and finds several hand cast bells on the graves they visit.

Maggie gets a feeling that something is wrong and she's right. The rest of the novel is how Maggie tries to discover what was wrong. She ends up being drugged and buried alive in a stolen casket. Her intended killer wants it to be a slow death thus has installed a breathing tube in the lid of the casket.

You'll have to read the novel to see if Maggie survives and who wants her dead and why. It's an absorbing story.
