December's Most Anticipated Books

The Frozen River by Ariel Lawhon Genre: Historical Fiction Release Date: December 5, 2023 Plot: Maine, 1789: When the Kennebec River freezes, entombing a man in the ice, Martha Ballard is summoned to examine the body and determine cause of death. As a midwife and healer, she is privy to much of what goes on behind closed doors in Hallowell. Her diary is a record of every birth and death, crime and debacle that unfolds in the close-knit community. Months earlier, Martha documented the details of an alleged rape committed by two of the town's most respected gentlemen—one of whom has now been found dead in the ice. But when a local physician undermines her conclusion, declaring the death to be an accident, Martha is forced to investigate the shocking murder on her own.

<u>The Paris Housekeeper</u> by Renee Ryan Genre: Historical Fiction Release Date: December 26, 2023 Plot: Camille Lacroix is a chambermaid at the famous hotel Ritz in Paris, and, despite German tanks occupying the city, she cannot leave in order to support her family. Vivian Miller appears to be a Nazi sympathizer, but is in fact, using her connections to obtain travel papers for Jewish refugees.

<u>The Curse of Penryth Hall</u> by Jess Armstrong Genre: Gothic Mystery Release Date: December 5, 2023 Plot: Ruby Vaughn is an American heiress who finds herself entwined in the eerie tale of Penryth Hall. When a box of books leads her back to the Cornish Countryside with a curse-shrouded past, Ruby teams up with Pellar, a curse-breaker and Ruan Kivell to unravel the secrets of the curse and break it before it can claim its next victim.

<u>The Weekend Retreat</u> by Tara Laskowski Genre: Thriller Release Date: December 26, 2023 Plot: The Van Ness siblings are heirs to a copper fortune and are gathering for a birthday celebration. Three couples, three days, one storm and the results are deadly.

The Vacation by John Marrs Genre: Thriller Release Date: December 19, 2023

Plot: Venice Beach, Los Angeles. A paradise on earth. Tourists flock to the golden coast and the promise of Hollywood. But for eight strangers at a beach-front hostel, there is far more on their minds than an extended vacation. All of them are running from something. And they all have secrets they'd kill to keep...

The Second Chance Year by Melissa Weisner Genre: Romance Release Date: December 5, 2023 Plot: After Sadie has lost her job, her payment, and her boyfriend, she jumps at the chance to make a wish with a fortuneteller. She wants to do-over. She wakes up the next morning and the date is January 1st of last year. She has her second chance, but is it everything she thought it would be?


God Save Benedict Arnold: The True Story of America's Most Hated Man by Jack Kelly





The Sound of Music - Friday, December 1

The children are unhappy and resentful of the governesses that he keeps hiring and have managed to run each of them off one by one. When Maria arrives, she is initially met with the same hostility, but her kindness, understanding, and sense of fun soon draws the children to her and brings some much-needed joy into all their lives, including the Captain's. Eventually he and Maria find themselves falling in love, even though he is already engaged to a Baroness named Elsa and Maria is still a postulant. The romance makes them both start questioning the decisions they have made. Their personal conflicts soon become overshadowed, however, by world events. Austria is about to come under Germany's control, and the Captain may soon find himself drafted into the German Navy and forced to fight against his own country. Released: 1965. 2 hours 52 minutes. Pearl Harbor - Monday, December 4

Pearl Harbor is a classic tale of romance set during a war that complicates everything. It all starts when childhood friends Rafe and Danny become Army Air Corps pilots and meet Evelyn, a Navy nurse. Rafe falls head over heels and he and Evelyn and Rafe hook up. Then Rafe volunteers to go fight in Britain, and Evelyn and Danny get transferred to Pearl Harbor. While Rafe is off fighting, suddenly one morning comes the air raid we now know as "Pearl Harbor." Released: 2001. 3 hours 3 minutes. Rated: PG-13. Starring: Ben Affleck and Kate Beckinsale

Later, as an adult who happened to be raised by elves, Santa allows him to go to New York City to find his birth father, Walter Hobbs. Walter is on Santa's naughty list for being a heartless jerk, and had no idea that Buddy was even born. Buddy, meanwhile, experiences the delights of New York City (and human culture) as only an elf can. When Walter's relationship with him interferes with his job, he is forced to reevaluate his priorities. Released 2003. 1 hour 37 minutes. Rated: PG. Starring: Will Ferrell and James Caan

Miracle on 34th Street - A man claiming to be Santa Claus is at first shunned by the community, but eventually, with the help of a little girl, even the most skeptical come to see that miracles really can happen. Believing in magic and learning how to see the world through the eyes of a child again are central in this delightful feature that captures the meaning of the holidays. Released 1957. 46 minutes. Not Rated.

White Christmas - Friday, December 29

Having left the Army following W.W.II, Bob Wallace and Phil Davis team up to become a top song-and-dance act. Davis plays matchmaker and introduces Wallace to a pair of beautiful sisters (Betty and Judy) who also have a song-and-dance act. When Betty and Judy travel to a Vermont lodge to perform a Christmas show, Wallace and Davis follow, only to find their former commander, General Waverly, as the lodge owner. A series of romantic mix-ups ensue as the performers try to help the General. Released 1954. 2 hours. Not Rated. Starring: Bing Crosby, Danny Kaye, Rosemary Clooney, and Vera-Ellen
