




#### The River We Remember

#### November's Most Anticipated Books

#### **The Look** by Michelle Obama

Genre: Nonfiction Release date: November 4, 2025

Plot: This is a book in Obama's words about how we present ourselves and how Obama's style evolved as the first African American First Lady. Obama includes stories about her approach to style as well as stories from her makeup artist, hairstylist, and designers.

#### **Book of Lives: A Memoir of Sorts** by Margaret Atwood

Genre: Nonfiction Release date: November 4, 2025

Plot: A memoir from one of the most influential writers of a generation. Atwood tells about her writing and the connections to her life.

#### Making Mary Poppins by Todd James Pierce

Genre: Nonfiction Release date: November 11, 2025

Plot: Mary Poppins is a Disney movie that still resonates today. This is the book that tells the story of how brothers, Robert and Richard Sherman, came to Disney studios to write the music for Mary Poppins. The book weaves the story of how the incredible masterpiece *Mary Poppins* came to be.

#### The Botanist's Assistant by Peggy Townend

Genre: Mystery Release date: November 18, 2025

Plot: Margaret Finch is over 6 feet tall, lives alone in the woods, and has an obsessive attention to all details. She works as an assistant to a botanist and is very good at her job. When someone at work is found dead, it is ruled an accident, but Margaret suspects it's murder. With her keen eye and the help of the night janitor, she is determined to find the murderer before they find her.

#### Mamba & Mambacita Forever by Vanessa Bryant

Genre: Nonfiction Release date: November 18, 2025

Plot: In 2020, Kobe Bryant and his daughter, Giana were tragically killed in a helicopter crash. In an outpouring of love, the public started putting up murals in seemingly every corner of Los Angeles. Vanessa Bryant provides a collection of the murals, with images and stories about them, to paint a

picture of her husband and daughter.



Stay open to unexpected opportunities.


